You may have seen our Facebook post about Ricky G.'s negative experience with trying to use public transportation when being confined to a wheelchair. Mobility issues pose a special challenge when trying to get to medical appointments that ride shares or public transportation may not be able to address. Accessible Care Transport drivers are certified in Passenger Assistance, Safety and Sensitivity (PASS), as well as CPR and Defensive Driving. You can be rest assured that we will get you or your loved one safely to their appointment or procedure and home again, providing comfort, compassion and conversation along the way.

Accessible Care Transport is thankful that we are able to assist people with mobility issues. Ricky found out about us on Facebook and gave us a call. We stopped over at his house the day before his appointment to introduce ourselves and make sure his wheelchair would fit on our ramp. ACT was able to get Ricky to his doctor safely and ON TIME!
