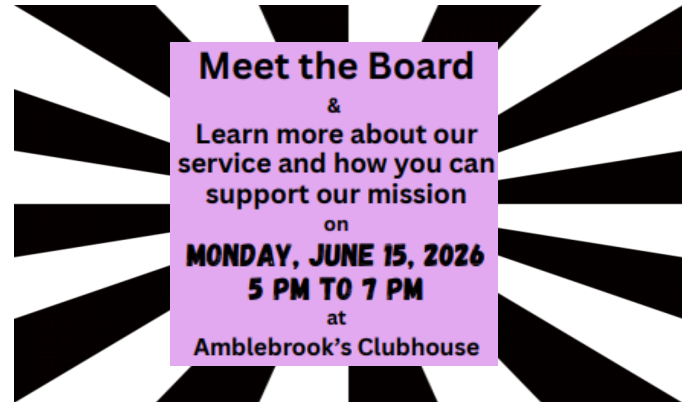
May Community ACTions

These funds have already made a direct impact by allowing us to provide free transportation for a client who is legally blind and in need of transportation to important medical appointments.
